MONTHLY ALUMNI MEETINGS

On January 24, there was an organizational meeting to discuss plans for 2023 and to establish a planning committee for the 100th anniversary celebration of Gamma Iota Chapter, which is scheduled for November 2025.

USS Kidd Museum Executive Director Parks Stephenson hosted a presentation on February 8 regarding the current status of the USS Kidd and plans for the future of the ship and museum.

On March 28, **Scott McKnight '91**, a candidate for Louisiana state treasurer, discussed the financial status of the state of Louisiana and his goals should he be elected.

On April 25, we honored six Gamma Iota graduating seniors and heard their success story, "Rebirth of the Gamma Iota Chapter," which detailed our growth from one member in 2018 to a fully functional Sigma Chi chapter of 150 members.

Dr. Beau Clark, East Baton Rouge Parish coroner, will be our guest speaker on May

23. He will provide information related to the impact of fentanyl on our local Baton Rouge population. Dr. Clark spoke to the Gamma Iota active chapter members about the perils of drug usage, especially regarding fentanyl—it was powerful and got their attention.

On June 27, we plan to have a happy hour gathering to allow participation from brothers who cannot make the lunch meetings.

Our third annual "Brotherhood & Bar-B-Que Feast" is scheduled for July 25. Gamma Iota Brother **Stephen Waguespack '96**, a candidate for Louisiana governor, will be our guest speaker.

ADDITIONAL ALUMNI UPDATES

Brothers **Tommy Bell '82**, **Rickey Heroman '76**, and **John Cadwallader '70** attended the Sigma Chi Transformational Leadership Mentor Training in Atlanta in January. Subsequently, they participated in the conduct of the P4B (Preparation for Brotherhood) and R4L (Ritual for Life) training prior to and after the March 9-10 initiation. As a Ritual Peer, John Cadwallader's job was to evaluate the conduct of the ritual during initiation. The chapter did an excellent job.

Alumni chapter, house corporation, and chapter advisory board representatives evaluated the applications for the six \$2,500 Lod Cook Sigma Chi Leadership Scholarships and submitted the names of applicants to the LSU Foundation. The scholarships for 2023-24 academic year will be awarded this summer.

Alumni also worked with the Sigma Chi Foundation to secure educational funds to purchase chairs for the Gamma Iota Library.

During the second annual Steve Carter Memorial Derby Days, the brothers raised just over \$82,000 for the Huntsman Cancer Research Institute. Over 700 women from every sorority on campus participated in field games, social events, and an online fundraising day. In just three years, Gamma Iota has been able to establish the single-largest men's philanthropy event on LSU's campus.

At the Greek Awards Banquet, Sigma Chi was awarded Most Outstanding Brotherhood, presented by the LSU Panhellenic Council. Due to our deep commitment to each other's well-being and prioritizing mental health, the brothers endeavor to ensure everyone has a strong support system. Showcasing the well-rounded nature of the brothers, Gamma Iota was also awarded the Best Tailgate on LSU's campus for fall 2022.

Gamma Iota continues to succeed academically, producing a GPA that ranks fifth among the 17 fraternities on campus. Forty-five brothers made the Dean's List or President's Honor Roll for their excellence in the classroom.

During the most recent spring initiation, which was planned by Kustos **Sam Elliott '24**, the brothers performed exceedingly well and received a grade of 99 to submit to Ritual Peer Training.
